

## **Black Lives Matter**

"It's early summer in Nevada County and all around us is quiet. Yet, across the nation there is devastating unrest and suffering which we cannot ignore. At <u>Nevada County Arts</u> <u>Council</u> we are deeply shaken and saddened by the violence toward, and murder of, black people. We stand in solidarity with their communities in support of equity and justice. Because we recognize that our silence implies complicity, we want to clearly voice this solidarity now.

At the same time, we would like to share with you our commitment to a pledge we took early last year in joining <u>OFBYFOR ALL</u>'s Change Network. Through joining this network, we are continuing to educate ourselves, hold ourselves accountable, and hold open dialogue about systemic barriers to equity, diversity and inclusion within our organization and our community.

During our first year, we partnered with the <u>Nevada City Rancheria Nisenan Tribe</u> whose Culture is critically endangered. Together with <u>Nevada City Film Festival</u>, we successfully applied for funding from the <u>California Arts Council</u> to create a film - led by the Nisenan - about the recovery of the Tribe's all but lost language and the fight to have their Federal Recognition restored. This work continues and you can learn about it <u>here</u>.

But we need to do more. Looking ahead, Nevada County Arts Council pledges a space for meaningful conversations on understanding and preventing racism, and unlocking best practices in cultural equity. We commit to working with you, our community, and with our many partners in the creative sector and beyond, to dismantle structural barriers and fight for racial equity. For now, we acknowledge the pain, frustration, fear, and sadness of black and brown people, and the racism that our own black and brown community members experience daily. We see you, we hear you, we stand with you.

In the coming days and weeks you will be hearing more from us as we invite you to reflect with us what this moment of reckoning means for the beautiful community in which we reside, and how we can make it a better place to live and visit for black people and people of color."

The Nevada County Relief Fund was created through a partnership between the County of Nevada, Sierra Nevada Memorial Hospital Foundation, Tahoe Truckee Community Foundation, and the Sierra Business Council in consultation with the Center for Nonprofit Leadership and the Economic Resource Council.

The Nevada County Relief Fund will open a new round of applications each time they raise an additional \$100,000. Their hope is to have multiple rounds of grantmaking for as long as there are funds to disburse. Donations are welcomed.


#### **Food Love Farm Tours with Sierra Harvest**




#### **COVID-19 Resources for the Creative Community**

## **COVID-19 Arts & Culture Early Impact Survey**

<u>Nevada County Arts Council</u> issued a creative sector survey for individuals and organizations on March 28, 2020 to gather early data on the impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency. 257 submissions were received at the closing of this initial survey on April 18, 2020.

This report includes information about the devastating losses to our creative community, together with the stories of strength and resilience for which our sector is known. and which will help our communities to heal, recover and build long-term resilience.

## **#GVNCCulturalDistrict on Instagram**


Grass Valley-Nevada City is one of 14 districts selected by The California Arts Council to serve as California's inaugural state-designated Cultural Districts. Each one of us is an
