

COVID-19 Arts & Culture Early Impact Survey

Nevada County Arts Council issued a creative sector survey for individuals and organizations on March 28, 2020 to gather early data on the impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency. 257 submissions were received at the closing of this initial survey on April 18, 2020.

This report includes information about the devastating losses to our creative community, together with the stories of strength and resilience for which our sector is known. and which will help our communities to heal, recover and build long-term resilience.

- Tuesday Farmers' Market, located in Pine Creek Shopping Center (in the Raley's parking lot), is open May 5th through September 29th, from 8:00am -



Nevada County Relief Fund

The <u>Nevada County Relief Fund</u> invites applications to its Small Businesses and Nonprofits Fund.

The Nevada County Relief Fund was created through a partnership between the County of Nevada, Sierra Nevada Memorial Hospital Foundation, Tahoe Truckee Community Foundation, and the Sierra Business Council in consultation with the Center for Nonprofit Leadership and the Economic Resource Council.

The Fund offers micro-grants of up to \$5,000 and creative sector organizations and small business are eligible to apply. **Applications are due by Tuesday, May 19th, and awardees will be announced by May 29th.**

Nevada County Relief Fund will open a new round of applications each time they raise an additional \$100,000. Their hope is to have multiple rounds of grantmaking for as long as there are funds to disburse. **If you would like to make a donation to the fund, you may do so here.**


