### The Onyx at Home

While temporarily closed, <u>The Onyx</u> will continue to offer a curated selection of first-run films via virtual screenings.

Films will change on a regular basis, and you can visit their <u>website</u> to see what's currently available. Click on the film's title and once you are on the film's webpage you can read more about the title and click "BUY VIRTUAL TICKET." This will take you to The Onyx's specific page on the film distributor's website where you can purchase your "ticket." Typically, at least 50% or more of these sales will support The Onyx. Tickets range from "Pay as You Wish" to \$12, and you only need purchase once per household. Their <u>"Virtual Screenings FAQ"</u> page provides more complete information.



# Art Works Gallery 10th Anniversary and Virtual Art Gallery

<u>Art Works Gallery</u>, voted "Best Gallery" in <u>the Union's "Best of Nevada County"</u> five years in a row, is celebrating its 10th anniversary. The gallery features <u>33 artists</u> in various media including ceramics, fiber arts, furniture, glass, jewelry, mixed media, mosaics, painting, photography, stone turning, and up-cycled art.

Closed temporarily due to COVID-19, they invite you to meet the artists one on one in their <u>Virtual Gallery</u>. Every two weeks they will be spotlighting ten artists. For the next two weeks they are spotlighting Suzanne Himmler, Yvon Dockter, Tom Haddy, Martha Jones, Gail Lipson, David Wong, Jerianne Van Dijk, Priscilla Roach, Margaret Lindsey and Jan Anderson.

The gallery is located at 113 Mill Street in downtown Grass Valley - and they hope that you will soon be able to visit them there again.




### #GVNCCulturalDistrict on Instagram


